

RESOLUTION OF THE HOOVER CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION

BE IT RESOLVED by the Hoover City Board of Education as follows:


WHEREAS, the Hoover City Board of Education (“the Board”) and the City of Hoover (“the City”) share a commitment to providing outstanding school athletic and public recreational programs and facilities to the Board’s students and to the City’s residents; and

WHEREAS, the Board and the City have determined that their common goals can best be met by working collaboratively to address identified facility needs on a cost-effective basis with a view toward making those facilities available to students and City residents in accordance with more detailed funding and shared facility use agreements; and

WHEREAS, the collaborative undertaking hereby envisioned and endorsed includes installation of artificial turf on the Hoover High School and Spain Park High School baseball fields, the installation of artificial turf and the construction of restroom facilities at the Hoover High School and Spain Park High School softball fields, and drainage improvements to athletic fields at Hoover High School and Spain Park High School;


NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Hoover City Board of Education authorizes its Superintendent to enter into a memorandum of understanding with the City of Hoover reflecting the general terms of the funding and shared use undertaking hereby contemplated and to develop such additional and more specific agreements as may be deemed necessary and appropriate to effectuate the goals and objectives of this Resolution, all of which shall be subject to the Board’s review and approval.
