Spain Park High School 2021 Summer School Agreement

The Hoover City Board of Education has provided the opportunity for me to attend the Summer School Program at Spain Park High School. I understand that my enrollment is conditioned upon my willingness to follow the normal school policies during this time. I will work hard to take advantage of this opportunity.

Attendance is mandatory!!

- **Students will not earn credit and will be dismissed if they miss** more than two (2) days.
-
- If a student is more than ten (10) minutes late to a class or if he/she checks out with more than ten (10) minutes remaining in the class, he/she will be counted absent for one-half (1/2) day.
- **Students will be referred to the office when tardy.**
- **Upon the second office referral for behavior**, a student will automatically be dismissed from Summer School.

Because Summer School is an optional opportunity, =misbehavior will not be tolerated!

- All school rules outlined in the 2020-2021 Code of Conduct are in effect. This includes but is not limited to rules regarding dress code, possession of illegal substances, and disrespectful behavior.
- While students may be referred to the office several times during the normal school year, administrators will consider the **second time** they see a student for misbehavior during Summer School as a **SECOND INCIDENT**, and the student will be **withdrawn**. For example, if a student has been disciplined for disrespect, he/she may be withdrawn for a first incident of tobacco possession.
- Students who are involved in any cheating incident during Summer School including but not limited to using another student's work, using written notes or reference materials not specifically authorized by the supervising teacher, or accessing the internet, using a cell phone, or opening electronic notes during computer assessments without prior teacher authorization will be referred to the office. A second incident of cheating will result in withdrawal from the Summer School program with no grade or refund.
- A student may be **withdrawn** on the **first incident** if the misbehavior is classified as a Class II or Class III offense. Reports will be made to the police when appropriate.
- Students who **drive** to Summer School must follow all rules regarding the use of personal vehicles on campus. The vehicle is subject to search for illegal substances or weapons.
- If a student is withdrawn for disciplinary or attendance reasons, there will be **NO REFUND** of tuition.

BE WHERE YOU ARE SUPPOSED TO BE AND BE THERE ON TIME.

The hours for Summer School will be: Monday – Friday, 8:00am – 1:00pm

*Summer School is an excellent opportunity to earn credits and work toward graduation. Don't lose this opportunity by missing class or misbehaving. If you have any questions about these rules, ask the question **before** you cross the line.*

Description of Credit Enhancement Courses

Health

- The class meets on the first day of the term. *This could change, based on the teacher's plans.
- All of the course work will be online and must be completed by **JULY 9th**.

Drivers Ed.

- **SPACE IS LIMITED** - PLEASE NOTE THE FIRST DAY TO SIGN UP IS MAY 4TH
- The class meets on the first day of the term for approximately 30 minutes. *ALL Driver's Ed students will meet on June 14th at either 8:00am or 1:00pm. YOU ARE EXPECTED TO BE IN HOOVER, AND AVAILABLE TO DRIVE, during either June or July
- Students will schedule with their instructor to drive on (at least) 2 additional days. Students must be flexible on these driving days .
- All course work and driving must be complete by June 20th..
- In order to participate in the driving portion of Driver's Ed, students must have a Learner's Permit prior to the start of summer school.

Note: The Health and Driver's Ed teachers will work together for the students they share in terms of in-classroom time. YOU CAN TAKE THESE TWO COURSES DURING THE SAME SESSION.

Government - only offered during Session 1 (students can sign up for both Econ/Gov or just take one course)

This is a nontraditional class that will be offered through Edgenuity, a computer based program.

- Students will meet on campus five days a week for three weeks. There will be no virtual option for this class.
- Because of the large amount of material to be learned, students must be willing to work outside of normal school hours. All course work must be complete by the end of the term.

Economics - only offered during Session 1 (students can sign up for both Econ/Gov or just take one course)

This is a nontraditional class that will be offered through Edgenuity, a computer based program.

- Students will meet on campus five days a week for three weeks. There will be no virtual option for this class.
- Because of the large amount of material to be learned, students must be willing to work outside of normal school hours. All course work must be completed by the end of the term.

Note: Many students are able to complete both Government and Economics within the first session because of the self-directed lessons and assignments.

P.E. Life (only available if enough students register)

- Students will be required to complete virtual assignments to meet the Life Course requirement of this course.
- Students will be required to keep an activity log to ensure that they are meeting the activity requirement.
- The class will meet one day a week at school for students to turn in their Activity Log and participate in a traditional Physical Education Class.
- Both Summer School terms are required to receive the PE Life credit.

Other academic courses can be considered on a case by case basis for Credit Enhancement using Edgenuity. Please discuss with your counselor.
